Headlines:

South Dakotans are joining in on nationwide protests against the Trump Administration. A 'Day of Action' was held on Saturday as part of the nonpartisan 50-50-1 movement. In Sioux Falls, protestors gathered at Van Eps Park. Many folks expressed their continued concerns with Trump's actions since taking office with signs and chants. A major food drive was also held to benefit Feeding South Dakota. At the Capitol in Pierre, close to a hundred people gathered on the sidewalks surrounding the Capitol building for a silent protest and community aid event.

No one is hurt after a house fire west of Sioux Falls over the weekend. The Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office says crews responded to a call about a structure fire on Saturday night south of Humboldt. They were able to put out the fire and save most of the home. The cause of the fire is still under investigation.

The state Capitol and Governor's Residence will undergo renovations. Lawmakers approved three-million dollars to help repair the aging facilities. The Capitol will get new plaster and paint on the walls, followed by repairs to the interior dome. Meantime, exterior changes will be made to the Governor's Residence for the first time since it was built in 2005. It's getting a black roof, gray siding, and black trim. Right now, the home is pale yellow and brown.

A Mitchell man is behind bars accused of leading officers on a chase and rolling his car in Brookings early Sunday morning. Police say Brandon Kendall was driving erratically and speeding just after 2 a.m. when police tried to pull him over. He allegedly didn't stop which started the police chase. Kendall reportedly tried to take a turn onto a bypass, failed, and rolled. The man suffered minor injuries and is now charged with DUI, eluding, and several other traffic violations.

A bill could increase speed limits on North Dakota interstates. The House proposal narrowly passed the Senate floor on Friday to raise interstate speed limits to 80 miles per hour. The bill would also increase speeding ticket fines and potentially add more points to driver's licenses for anyone violating specific traffic laws. Governor Kelly Armstrong will now decide if the proposal is signed into law.

Insulin prices will be more affordable in North Dakota. Governor Kelly Armstrong signed a bill to bring insulin prices to 25-dollars per month for state residents. Supporters believe the cap was needed to widen access to North Dakotans.

Grand Forks authorities are looking for a suspect responsible for vandalizing a sacred memorial. The bronze statue in the city's Northern Valley Law Enforcement Memorial now has a large crack after someone likely kicked it. The Grand Forks Police Department asks anyone with information to submit their tips over the phone or on the agency's Facebook page.


